ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM


CAP-HC is one of the largest providers of energy assistance in Minnesota. Each year, our Energy Assistance Program (EAP) helps thousands of eligible Hennepin County residents by providing utility bill assistance grants directly to utility providers. The current program year runs from Oct. 1, 2022 through May 31, 2023.

CRISIS WATER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Crisis water funds are available for eligible households with a past due blanace, disconnection of service notice, or water shut off. As with EAP grants, water bill assistance grants are paid directly to utility providers.



ENERGY RELATED REPAIR PROGRAM

The Energy Related Repair Program provides emergency repair or replacement of broken/ non-functioning heating systems, such as a furnace, for EAP clients.

To be eligible for assistance with your heating system you must submit an Energy Assistance Application and be approved.



WEATHERIZATION ASSISTANCE REFERRALS

Looking to permanently reduce your energy costs? Through the Weatherization Assistance Program, qualifying renters and homeowners can get free home energy upgrades to ensure they have a safe, healthy, and energy efficient home.
